<b>October 12</b>	<b>Canned Fruit</b> Peaches, Pears, Fruit Cocktail, Apple Sauce, Pineapple
<b>October 19</b>	<b>Canned Meats</b> Tuna, Salmon, Chicken, Ham, Corned Beef, Stew
<b>October 26</b>	<b>Soups and Juices</b> Chicken, Vegetable, Onion, Tomato Soups Orange, Apple, Grape, Cranberry, Pineapple Juices
<b>November 2</b>	<b>Pasta and Sauces, Rice, Quinoa</b>
<b>November 9</b>	<b>Breakfast Cereals, Baby Food, Baby Cereals</b>
<b>November 16</b>	<b>Basic Pantry Supplies</b> Sugar, Flour, Baking Soda, Baking Powder, Brown Sugar, Salt, Pepper, Corn Starch, Cooking Oil, Tea, Instant Coffee
